There was a total of 37 puppies on the premises at the time of inspection. The kennel's exercise plan and rabies certification letter were viewed.</p> <p>The inspection of May 4, 2017 is as follows:</p> <p>21.21(c)/Act 207(b) - Drainage</p> <p>Prior unsatisfactory has been corrected.</p> <p>21.22(d)/Act 207(b) - Housing</p> <p>Wardens observed puppies not acclimated to the outdoor temperatures housed in outdoor facilities. Young dogs were viewed shivering during inspection.</p> <p>Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):</p> <p>Dogs that are not acclimated to the outdoor temperatures prevalent in the area or region where they are</p>							



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maintained, breeds of dogs that cannot tolerate the prevalent outdoor temperatures without stress or discomfort (such as short-haired breeds in cold climates), and sick, infirm, aged or young dogs may not be kept in outdoor facilities unless that practice is specifically approved by the attending veterinarian.

21.23(a)/Act 207(b) - Run Space

Prior unsatisfactory has been corrected.

21.23(b)/Act 207(b) - Run Dimensions

Prior unsatisfactory has been corrected.

21.24(a)/Act 207(b) - Shelter

Wardens observed puppies that did not have access to adequate shelter.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Provide dogs access to shelter which protects them against inclement weather, preserves their body heat and keeps them dry. Construct housing facilities for dogs to provide for the health and comfort of the animals.

21.24(b)/Act 207(b) - Bedding

Wardens observed shelters that did not have sufficient bedding or other means of protection from the weather provided for dogs.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Provide shelter for dogs kept outdoors and provide sufficient clean bedding material or other means of protection from the weather.

21.25(a)/Act 207(b) - Temperature

Wardens observed puppies shivering in the kennel, which was not maintained at a level to protect the health and comfort of the type of puppies housed.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Maintain the kennel temperature at a level to protect the health and comfort of the type of dogs housed.

21.28(c)/Act 207(b) - Food/Water Receptacles

Wardens observed a sprinkler type water system in one primary enclosure, which drained over a board into a second separate primary enclosure. The board, over which the water was flowing, was dirty with mud and/or feces. Puppies in the second primary enclosure were expected to drink the water flowing over the end of the board.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Food and water receptacles shall be accessible to dogs kept in the kennel and shall be located to avoid contamination by excreta. The receptacles shall be durable and shall be kept clean.

21.29(a)/207(b) - Excreta

Prior unsatisfactory has been corrected.

21.29(b)/207(b) - Sanitation

Prior unsatisfactory has been corrected.

21.29(c)/Act 207(b) - Housekeeping

Wardens found several miscellaneous metal objects on the ground in the primary enclosures where dogs were being kept.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Maintain the buildings and grounds of the kennel and keep them clean and in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to facilitate practices required by this chapter.

21.41(a)/Act 207(c) - Records

Wardens viewed records that did not contain the necessary information for all dogs kept within the kennel. Some dogs that left the kennel were missing the date they left, the name of the person who acquired them, and/or where they went.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):



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Ensure that all dogs kept within the kennel at any time are maintained on record and keep said records for at least two years. Such records shall show, but are not limited to, the breed, color, markings, sex and age of each dog, the date the dog entered the kennel, the full name and address of the previous owner, the date the dog leaves the kennel, how the dog was dispensed and the full name and address of where the dog goes.

21.41(b)/Act 207(b) - Records on State Forms

Prior unsatisfactory has been corrected.

21.30/Act 207(b) - Condition of Dog

There were two (2) dogs viewed in the kennel that were in obvious need of veterinary attention.

A juvenile, female, red and white King Charles Cavalier Spaniel-type puppy was viewed to have labored breathing with a productive cough and gagging. A gurgling sound could be heard in her chest. A pronounced abdominal component was present in her breathing. Her respiratory rate was abnormally fast or tachypneic, and her mucous membranes were pale pink. Her body condition was thin with prominent vertebral spinal processes palpable and visible. She was shivering intermittently. The kennel owner did not have proof of adequate veterinary care for the dog.

A juvenile, male, black Scottish terrier-type puppy was seen isolating itself from the other puppies in the primary enclosure. The puppy appeared to be lethargic and listless, unlike the other puppies, and had a depressed demeanor. Closer evaluation revealed a very thin body condition in which his ribs, spinal processes, hip bones and shoulder blades could be easily palpated. His mucous membranes were pale pink to grey. The kennel owner did not have proof of adequate veterinary care for the dog.

A cruelty referral for both puppies was made to a Lancaster County detective and PSCPA.

Act 603(b) - Selling, bartering or trading dogs

No pups under 8 weeks of age were brought into or transferred from the kennel since the previous inspection.

Following the inspection, wardens served the kennel owner with a kennel license refusal notice from the Bureau of Dog Law Enforcement.

The kennel was not in compliance with the provisions of the Act and its regulations as of the date and time of the inspection.

There was a total of 46 puppies on the premises. The kennel's exercise plan and rabies certification letter were viewed. The inspection was conducted with Supervisor Kristen Penn and Dog Law Veterinarian Danielle Ward DVM.</p> <p>The inspection of March 16, 2017 is as follows:</p> <p>21.21(c)/Act 207(b) - Drainage</p> <p>Wardens observed standing water in an enclosure and frozen water in an enclosure that were housing puppies. Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):</p> <p>Provide adequate drains to rapidly eliminate excess water from housing facilities.</p> <p>21.22(d)/Act 207(b) - Housing</p> <p>Wardens observed puppies not acclimated to the outdoor temperatures housed in outdoor facilities. Young dogs were viewed shivering during inspection.</p>								



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Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Dogs that are not acclimated to the outdoor temperatures prevalent in the area or region where they are maintained, breeds of dogs that cannot tolerate the prevalent outdoor temperatures without stress or discomfort (such as short-haired breeds in cold climates), and sick, infirm, aged or young dogs may not be kept in outdoor facilities unless that practice is specifically approved by the attending veterinarian.

21.23(a)/Act 207(b) - Run Space

Wardens observed enclosures that were not constructed or maintained to provide sufficient space for all the puppies housed within.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Construct and maintain primary enclosures to provide sufficient space to allow each dog to turn about freely and to stand erect, sit and lie down in a comfortable, normal position.

21.23(b)/Act 207(b) - Run Dimensions

Wardens observed puppies confined in enclosures that did not meet the minimum amount of floor-space as required.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Provide each dog housed in a primary enclosure with a minimum amount of floor space as required.

21.24(a)/Act 207(b) - Shelter

Wardens observed puppies provided access to inadequate shelter.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Provide dogs access to shelter which protects them against inclement weather, preserves their body heat and keeps them dry. Construct housing facilities for dogs to provide for the health and comfort of the animals.

21.24(b)/Act 207(b) - Bedding

Wardens observed shelters that did not have sufficient bedding or other means of protection from the weather provided for dogs.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Provide shelter for dogs kept outdoors and provide sufficient clean bedding material or other means of protection from the weather.

21.25(a)/Act 207(b) - Temperature

The temperature of the kennel was not maintained at a level to protect the health and comfort of the type of puppies housed. Wardens observed puppies shivering in the kennel.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Maintain the kennel temperature at a level to protect the health and comfort of the type of dogs housed.

21.29(a)/Act 207(b) - Excreta

Wardens observed excreta within the kennel that had not been removed on a daily basis.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Remove excreta from the primary enclosure, including any floor area or ground surface beneath the primary enclosure, on a daily basis.

21.29(b)/Act 207(b) - Sanitation

Wardens observed primary enclosures that evidenced an excess build-up of feces/dirt/debris. Additionally, the kennel owner presented a bottle of sanitizing agent that was frozen.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Sanitize primary enclosures for dogs a minimum of once daily and as often as necessary to prevent an accumulation of debris or excreta or a disease hazard. Do not place a dog in a previously occupied primary enclosure unless the enclosure has been sanitized. Ensure that sanitizing products are stored properly so they are not rendered ineffective.

21.29(c)/Act 207(b) - Housekeeping



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Wardens observed a buildup of dust on primary enclosures.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Maintain the buildings and grounds of the kennel and keep them clean and in good repair to protect animals from injury and to facilitate practices requires by this chapter.

21.41(a)/Act 207(c) - Records Kept

Wardens viewed records that did not contain necessary information for all dogs kept within the kennel. Some dogs kept within the kennel were not listed on records, and records for other dogs that left the kennel were missing the date they left, the name of the person who acquired them, and/or where they went.

This warden directs the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Ensure that all dogs kept within the kennel at any time are maintained on record and keep said records for at least 2 years. Such records shall show, but are not limited to, the breed, color, markings, sex and age of each dog, the date the dog entered the kennel, the full name and address when the dog was received from the previous owner, the date the dog leaves the kennel, how the dog was dispensed, and the full name and address of where the dog goes.

21.41(b)/207(c): Records on State Forms

Records that were not on state issued forms as required were viewed for dogs kept within the kennel. Records pertaining to three (3) golden retriever mixed type puppies were not on state-issued forms.

This warden directs the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Maintain kennel records as required by section 207 of the act. These records shall be maintained on forms issued or approved by the state. Said kennel does not have approval to maintain records on forms other than those that are state issued.

Act 402(d) - Vet Check

A veterinary examination was ordered on (2) dogs under section 402(a) based on wardens' observations of the condition of dogs during an inspection. Kennel is in compliance with section 402(d) because the veterinary examination was completed within the 72 hour timeframe.

Act 207(e) - Display of licensing

Kennel owner has applied for a 2017 kennel license application. Application is pending.

Act 603(b) - Selling, bartering or trading dogs

Wardens observed a litter of puppies that were brought into the kennel prior to 8 weeks of age.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action(s):

Do not barter, trade, raffle, sell, auction or in any way transfer ownership of a dog under 8 weeks of age unless the dog has been orphaned and it becomes necessary to transfer ownership of the orphaned dog to a nonprofit kennel, or from a nonprofit kennel with approval by a licensed doctor of veterinary medicine.

The kennel was not in compliance with the provisions of the Act and its regulations as of the date and time of the inspection.

A re-inspection will take place at a later date.

Inspection of the kennel took place on January 12, 2017. There was a total of 5 adult dogs on the property and 29 puppies. The kennel's exercise plan and rabies certification letter were viewed. The inspection took place with Dog Law Supervisor Kristen Penn and Danielle Ward D.V.M.

The inspection of January 12, 2017 is as follows:

Act 402.d - Vet Check

A veterinary examination was ordered on (3) dogs under section 402(a) based on warden's observations of the condition of dog during the inspection. The dogs were: a Pomeranian puppy that was listless and dehydrated, had pale mucous membranes, and rapid, shallow breathing; a Boston terrier puppy with a "cherry" eye; and a papillon puppy with excessive discharge from his eyes. The kennel is in compliance with section 402(d) because the veterinary examinations were completed within the 72 hour time frame.

Act 207(e) - Display of License

Kennel owner has submitted a 2017 kennel license application. The license is pending.

21.29(a)/Act 207(b) - Excreta

Wardens viewed numerous piles of feces in the outdoor exercise yards of primary enclosures. The kennel owner admitted he does not clean up feces in the exercise yards of the primary enclosures.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action:

Remove excreta from the primary enclosures, including any floor area or ground surface beneath the primary enclosures, on a daily basis.

21.29(c)/Act 207(b) - Housekeeping/Pests

Wardens viewed an entire broken bag of sodden dog food lying on the ground in one of the primary enclosures. Puppies in the enclosure were standing on and eating the food, which the kennel owner said was two years old and which he placed there to soak up excess moisture in a muddy area.

Wardens directed the kennel owner to take the following action:

Maintain the buildings and grounds of the kennel, keep them clean and in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to facilitate the practices required by regulations.

This kennel was not in compliance with the Act and its regulations as of the date and time of inspection.

A re-inspection will take place at a later date.

The inspection of the kennel took place on June 14, 2016. There were a total of 59 puppies on the premises at the time of the inspection. The kennel's 2016 license was viewed and on display. The exercise plan and rabies certification letter were viewed.

The inspection of June 14, 2016 is as follows:

Act 207(b)/Regulation 21.28(c) - Food/Water Receptacles

This warden viewed a build up of dirt and dust on both the self-feeders and the self-water containers in the kennel.

This Warden directs that the kennel owner take the following action(s):

Food and water receptacles shall be accessible to dogs kept in the kennel and shall be located to avoid contamination by excreta. The receptacles shall be durable and shall be kept clean. Self-feeders and waterers may be used but shall be sanitized regularly to prevent molding, deterioration or caking of feed.

Act 207(b)/Regulation 21.29(b) - Sanitation

This warden viewed a heavy build-up of dirt on the interior walls of the kennel pens.

This warden directs that the kennel owner take the following action(s):

Primary enclosures for dogs shall be sanitized a minimum of once daily, and as often as is necessary to prevent an accumulation of debris or excreta or a disease hazard. A dog may not be placed in a primary enclosure previously occupied unless the enclosure has been sanitized.

Act 207(b)/Regulation 21.29(c) - Housekeeping/Pests

This warden viewed: a buildup of dirt and cobwebs along the ceiling and lights of the kennel; unused heat lights and other implements covered with dust in the kennel; puppies escaping from the fenced exercise yard of the kennel and from a temporary holding pen in the yard where puppies are placed when they arrive; a large roll or ball of unused wire in the exercise yard surrounding the kennel; a loose piece of small fencing attached to the bottom of a larger piece of a fence which was hooked to the rear of the kennel building, and boards and other debris, such as old fencing, in a separate holding area where puppies are placed when people come to view them.

This warden directs that the kennel owner take the following action(s):

The buildings and grounds of kennels shall be maintained, kept clean and in good repair to protect the animal from injury and to facilitate practices required by this chapter. Kennels shall have an effective program that controls ingress by insects, ectoparasites and avian and mammalian pests. Evidence of insects, ectoparasites and avian and mammalian pests or conditions that would allow or encourage infestation in a kennel are indicative of an ineffective program and unsanitary environmental sanitation in a kennel.

****A re-inspection will be conducted at a later date.**
